

OXFORD GUN CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2019

Overview:

Oxford Gun Club is establishing a scholarship program to reward youth shooters with assistance toward accredited post secondary education.

General Procedures:

- Each applicant must have graduated from high school with a minimum 3.0 cumulative Grade Point Average
- Each prospective recipient must be registered and have completed one semester before the scholarship is awarded.
- This is a one-time, non-renewable scholarship.
- Applicants may not be in receipt of any “full” scholarship funds in order to qualify (i.e., athletics, military academy, academic, etc.).
- Applicants must be an active OGC member and participate in at least one of the disciplines offered at the club (trap, skeet, wobble, sporting clays, pistol or rifle).

Applicants must be able to complete all parts of the application packet.

- Two recommendations from individuals well known to you, but not related to you. One should be a school related contact and the other from outside of school.
- One page student resume including school and non-school sports/activities/honors/volunteer service.
- One page essay (see attached guidelines)
- Current official academic transcript

A one page essay of no less than 250 words on one of the following topics must be included in your application packet. This is an opportunity for you to let the Scholarship Committee know more about you in a manner that your formal application, resume, or transcript may not convey. This essay must be typed in 12 point font and double spaced on a single 8 1/2 x 11 sheet of paper. Please include your full name in the upper right hand corner of your essay. Keep in mind, OGC related essays are appreciated and may be re-printed for use in our advertising and promotion of our scholarship program. Essays longer than one page will be discarded.

Essay Topics: (choose one)

- Explain a personal experience that has shaped your character, abilities, and/or achievements.
- Describe any exceptional achievements or special talents you may possess (ex. Music, shooting, art, leadership, athletics, bilingual proficiency, etc)
- Describe your educational goals, and reasons for your choice of major, and/or educational program..
- Describe what participating in shooting means to you.
- Describe a situation that took place while you were participating at OGC or any other shooting venue that may have helped define you as a person.
